Screening and Defensive Measures of COVID-19 Outbreak

According to the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi in the subject of Screening and Defensive Measures of COVID-19 Outbreak, dated on 14 and 21 February 2020, it is reported that the situation has severely spread to several countries including Thailand with the incubation period of 2-14 days to show symptoms (37.5 Celsius fever, cough, runny nose, shortness of breath) and its relatively easy transmission route via respiratory droplets and contact with the infected patients. Thailand's Ministry of Public Health has been recently announced that the following countries or areas pose the risk of getting infected:

- (1) China
- (2) Hong Kong
- (3) Macau
- (4) Taiwan
- (5) South Korea
- (6) Japan
- (7) Singapore
- (8) Malaysia
- (9) Vietnam

The school is deeply concerned about this situation and has therefore announced the following measures to maintain well-being of its students and staff members:

1. Permission shall not be granted to students and staff members to travel to or transit in the countries or areas at risk of COVID-19 infection as designated above from now on until the outbreak is fully controlled.

2. Students or staff members, who have traveled to or transit in countries or areas at risk of COVID-19 infection and arrived back in Thailand before this announcement, are obligated to refrain from going to classes or work in order to be monitored for 14 days after the date of arrival in Thailand. Such absence shall not be counted as dereliction of duty or leave days.

Student facilitators who acknowledge the absence from classes according to the first paragraph may assign the absentee through parents to keep up lessons that may miss.

3. Students or staff members, who stay with relatives traveling to or transiting in countries or areas at risk of COVID-19 infection and arriving back in Thailand, are requested to notify the school as soon as they acknowledge.

In addition, all students, parents and staff members shall strictly cooperate with the school to follow these practices;

1. Parents are requested to observe students' sickness symptoms. If they have fever with more than 37.5 Celsius or respiratory symptoms (e.g. coughing, sore throat, runny nose, shortness of breath), they are obligatory to go for screening and monitoring for infection at qualified medical facilities, and report the results and notify the school as soon as possible.
2. All students, parents and staff members are requested to avoid entering crowded public areas if not necessary during this period of time.
3. All students, parents and staff members are requested to follow good hygienic practices against virus infection, such as washing hands with soaps or alcohol gel, eating fully cooked food, not using the same utensils with others, and wearing a hygienic mask when entering public areas.
