



Announcement of Darunsikkhalai School for Innovative Learning

Updates on Academic Trimester 3/2020

---

Due to the current outbreak of the novel coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic with reportedly increasing cases of local transmission in almost entire the country, the school has been deeply concerned about the well-being of staff, students, and parents. With the necessity to follow the announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, complying with the measures of the government, the school has thus announced the updates on Academic Trimester 3/2020 in order to maintain the quality of the learner-centered education under the outbreak of COVID-19 as following details:

1. Academic Trimester 3/2020 will take place from **January 18<sup>th</sup> to April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021** instead of January 11<sup>th</sup> to April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021. For the first 6 weeks (January 18<sup>th</sup> to February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021) or until further notice, all classes will be conducted through online platforms in combination of offline student's self-study (Home-based Learning method).
2. Until the trimester officially starts, all staff, students, and parents will be ensured for the efficiency of learning tools and devices which is adequate for Home-based Learning method.
3. PTA Meeting will be carried out online through Zoom Meeting during January 12<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021 for the official acknowledgment of Home-based Learning method, as well as the guidelines regarding how to take care of children and promote their learning experience under the outbreak of COVID-19. The meeting schedule for each classroom will be confirmed through Line group sooner.

The school is well aware that learning through online platforms is less efficient than learning at the school. However, after careful consideration, the school has to adapt itself to fit in the situation while maintaining the duration of 12 weeks for each academic trimester. Also, to continually develop the school's pedagogy towards the utmost efficiency of learning, the school would like all staff to collectively contribute for the learning standard with the close support of parents.
